 - 4) Work with future Education and Mentoring Committees to provide access to NAHB Scholarship Program

Committee Co-Chairs:

- Develop Philanthropy and outreach priorities and goals
- Conduct committee meetings that will foster a positive and inclusive environment
- Create sub-groups within the committee to focus on program priorities and meaningful causes to the PWB sub-groups will report back to the committee with details.
- Research and vet opportunities and specific organizations for volunteering, partnering and outreach
- Explore how we can expand our reach, impact and influence. Chairs should share Philanthropy direction and decisions with PWB Board and Committee Chairs and work with other committees as it pertains to communication of their activities.
- Prepare yearly schedule containing events and goals
- Generate content for social media of the activities, to be communicated to Communications committee
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- Chairs will submit philanthropy programs to board through liaison for approval
